The PLANT @ Breeze program seeks to revitalize agricultural activity in Orange County and the Piedmont Region through training on small scale sustainable farming techniques with a focus on vegetable production.

Trainees may farm their own land or lease land at the Breeze Farm, 6 miles north of Hillsborough. The PLANT @ Breeze program will provide some equipment and tools for use at the Breeze Farm.

All apprentices leasing land at Breeze must complete the 8-week training course and submit a business plan and field crop plan by February 15, 2010.
